Winners

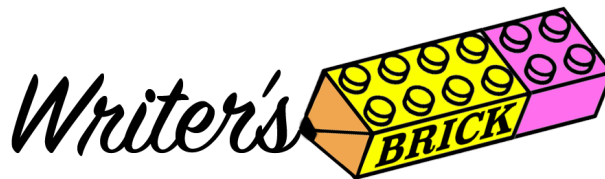
